The Diploma in Bible

The Diploma in Bible is an eighteen credit hour program which builds upon the biblical foundations taught in the Certificate program. The Diploma is a second year of academic study of the Holy Scriptures, designed to provide students an extended, in-depth examination and application of the Bible. Requirements necessary to enroll: successful completion of the Certificate in Bible, or the equivalent by transfer from another recognized educational institution.

Graduates of this program will be able to:

1. Display competence to teach and/or preach the word of God.
2. Demonstrate biblically-informed leadership skills for service in the church.
3. Evidence a biblical foundation for daily life.

BC 325: Survey of the Apocrypha (3 credit hours)

BC 405: Inductive Bible Study Methods (3 credit hours)

BC 455: Sermon Preparation and Homiletics (3 hours)

*MI 467: Homiletics Seminar (1 hour)

2 to 6 additional credit hours in Bible

3 additional credit hours in theology and/or apologetics

3 additional credit hours in practical theology

18 total credit hours
